RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collaborate with all ministries to integrate Student Ministry into the larger church.
- Identify, recruit and equip students and adult leaders to implement the student ministry efforts.
- Recruit/lead a youth/parent team to ensure inclusiveness, transparency and effective communication about ministry.
- Establish and maintain effective relationships with students and parents throughout the church.
- Promote the student ministry program to non-active and prospective students in our mission field.
- Supervise all staff and volunteers involved in leading youth-related activities.
- Utilize the latest resources, trends and topics relevant to student ministry to reach students.
- Seek educational opportunities to continue to develop personal spiritual, leadership and professional growth.
- Plan, organize, direct and evaluate activities including Confirmation class, mission/service, small groups and worship.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A Bachelor’s Degree is required.
- Ability to communicate a sense of call to student ministry and a firm theological background.
- Three to five years of leadership experience is preferred.
- Experienced in church participation and leadership.
- Must complete background check and Safe Sanctuary certification.

This is a full-time, salaried position eligible for our employee benefit program. This position has supervisory responsibilities and reports directly to our senior pastor.
